

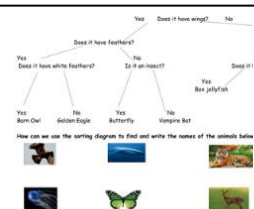
## GEOGRAPHY

# Summer 1 Newsletter 2026 Year 3

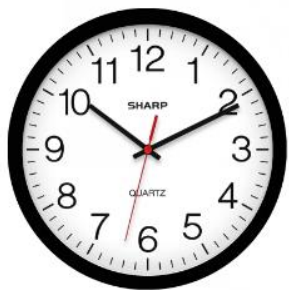
**We wanted to update you on a few things you may need to know this half term.**
