We will finish our Sikhism unit and move on to a thematic unit on religion and art.

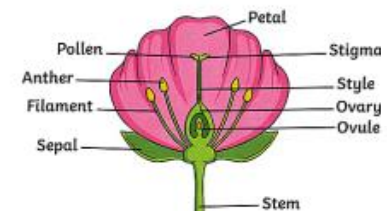

Parts of a Plant



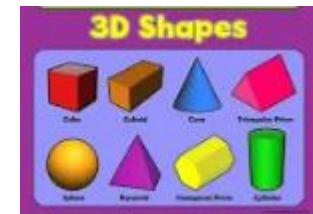
We are learning about parts of a plant in Science.
