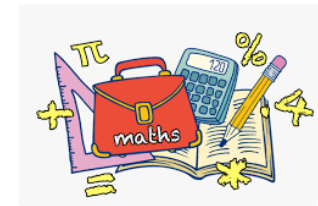

**We wanted to update/remind you on a few things you may need to know this term.**

**Reading** – Reading for pleasure is the key to reading success, so reading any story to your child will be of huge benefit to them. Please continue to snuggle up and read together. **Don't forget to sign your child's reading record!**
